For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, the terms “**us**”, “**we**” and “**our**” means Katana Applications Ltd (“**Katana**”), the terms “**you**”, “**your**” or “**yours**” means the individual visiting, using or subscribing to content from, the Katanaapp.com Site (“**Site**”)

WE RESPECT THE PRIVACY OF OUR ONLINE VISITORS, USERS AND SUBSCRIBERS. WE RECOGNISES THE IMPORTANCE OF PROTECTING INFORMATION COLLECTED FROM USERS AND AS SUCH, HAVE DEVELOPED THIS PRIVACY POLICY TO INFORM YOU ABOUT HOW WE GATHER, STORE, AND USE INFORMATION DERIVED FROM YOUR USE OF THE SITE, YOUR ACCOUNT AND ALL CONTENT AND SUBSCRIPTIONS. THIS POLICY MAY BE AMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME TO REFLECT AMENDMENTS AND/OR ADDITIONS TO OUR PRIVACY POLICY. PLEASE CHECK BACK FOR THE MOST CURRENT VERSION BEFORE RELYING ON ANY OF THE PROVISIONS IN THIS PRIVACY POLICY.

1. Collecting Information

By visiting and/or using our Site, content and subscriptions, you agree that we collect and process personally identifiable information (as defined in Section 2 – Personal Data) that you provide when: (a) creating an account; and/or (b) downloading software; and/or (c) purchasing subscriptions; and/or (d) during any communications with us in connection with the use of your account. We will not share any personally identifiable information with other parties except as described in this policy. We also process anonymous data, aggregated or individual, in order to analyse and produce statistics related to the habits, usage patterns, and demographics of users as a group or as individuals. Anonymous data does not allow the identification of the users to which it relates. We may share anonymous data, aggregated or individual, with third parties.

2. Personal Data

“**Personal Data**” is information that can be used to uniquely and specifically identify you, such as your name, address or PayPal account details. You may be asked to provide Personal Data when creating an account on the Site, downloading software and/or purchasing subscriptions. While we collect Personal Data on a voluntary basis, in certain circumstances, it may be a requirement for access and use of certain software and/or subscriptions and to process your orders.

3. Use of Personal Data

We use Personal Data internally to: (a) deliver software and subscriptions when purchased by you; and/or (b) develop and improve software, content our subscription services; and/or (c) to answer specific requests that you may make to us from time to time. In addition, we may allow third parties performing services under contract with us, such as payment processors, located in and outside of the European Union, to access and use Personal Data, but only to the extent necessary to provide those specific services. We may use Personal Data provided by you, to send you relevant information about us, including news about software updates, contests, events, and other

promotional materials, but only if you agree to receive such communications. We provide an opt in/opt out function for receipt of these communications, manageable via your account. We will not share any Personal Data with third parties for marketing purposes without your consent. When you create an account on our Site, we will collect your email address, username, first and last name. Depending on settings, you agree that some of this information may be searchable and available to other users of our Site. We have no obligation to keep private, any Personal Data that you make available to other users via Katana, other software, or other public functions. External websites and companies with links to and from the Site and/or subscriptions may collect Personal Data about you when you visit their websites. The Katana Privacy Policy does not extend to external websites and/or companies with links to or from the Site and/or subscriptions that collect Personal Data. Please refer directly to these companies and/or websites regarding their individual Privacy Policies. We may release Personal Data to comply with court orders or laws that require us to disclose such information. In the event of a reorganisation, sale or merger we may transfer Personal Data to the relevant third party with your consent as required by law.

4. Storage and Security of Personal Data

Personal Data provided to us by you, will be collected and processed by Katana Applications Ltd, operating within the EU; this data will be stored on Microsoft Azure servers and Firebase servers. We will take reasonable steps to protect the information you share with us, including, but not limited to, setup of processes, equipment and software to avoid unauthorised access or disclosure of this information.

4. Updating or Removal of Personal Data

If you wish to review, access or amend, or you would like us to remove your Personal Data from the servers, please let us know via the contact us page on our Site. We may reject requests that require unnecessary levels of technical interference, where it is extremely impractical to do so or that jeopardise the privacy of others Personal Data.
